RESOLUTION OF RECOGNITION

WHEREAS, Christine Mignogna, who has dedicated 29 years of service to the City of Newport News, has been named the 2009 Certified Zoning Administrator of the Year by the Virginia Association of Zoning Officials; and

WHEREAS, the Virginia Association of Zoning Officials, created in 1990, was one of the first organizations in the United States devoted to providing the highest quality training and certification requirements for all land use professionals. The Certified Zoning Administrator of the Year Award is awarded to the Zoning Administrator who has best demonstrated consistency in the interpretation and enforcement of local zoning ordinances and Virginia law, and who has demonstrated innovative programs or problem solving techniques related to saving time, money, or lives, or that otherwise benefit the community; and

WHEREAS, Christine Mignogna began her career with the City of Newport News on November 16, 1980, as an inspector for the city's Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program. She became a Property Maintenance Inspector in 1983, was promoted to Senior Codes Compliance Inspector in 1986, and in 1999 was promoted to her current position of Zoning Administrator; and

WHEREAS, in being named the Certified Zoning Administrator of the Year, Christine Mignogna has been recognized by her peers for her long standing commitment and dedication to providing the highest level of service to the City of Newport News, and for that the Council of the City of Newport News, Virginia, wishes to acknowledge this outstanding achievement and to thank Christine Mignogna for her continued devoted service to the citizens of the City of Newport News.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Newport News, Virginia:
