

RESOLUTION NO. 11914-09

WHEREAS, the City of Newport News (the "City") has determined that it is necessary to make improvements to the Public Safety Building for the purpose of addressing life, health and safety issues; and

WHEREAS, the State Board of Corrections approved the Planning Study on September 17, 2008, and the General Assembly included authorization in Item 280 of the 2009 Appropriations Act for the Virginia Public Building Authority to issue bonds to reimburse the City for 25% of the cost of addressing the safety issues in the maximum amount of \$428,125.00; and

WHEREAS, the City has submitted to the Department of Corrections an Updated Planning Study dated September 24, 2009, that reflects the cost of addressing additional life, health and safety issues at the Public Safety Building; and

WHEREAS, the City needs approval of the Updated Planning Study from the State Board of Corrections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Newport News, Virginia:

1. That the City requests the State Board of Corrections to approve the Updated Planning Study for the additional life, health and safety improvements to the Public Safety Building.
2. That the City requests reimbursement of 25% of the eligible costs of such additional improvements to the Public Safety Building.
3. That this resolution shall be in effect on and after the date of its adoption, October 13, 2009.
