

RESOLUTION NO. 11707-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWPORT NEWS, VIRGINIA, DECLARING THE TERMINATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY THAT WAS DECLARED AS A RESULT OF TROPICAL STORM HANNA.

WHEREAS, Section 44-146.21 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, prescribes the necessary action required by localities to adopt a declaration of local emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Newport News adopted Resolution No. 11706-08 on September 9, 2008, which resolution confirmed the declaration by the Director of Emergency Management of a local emergency necessitated as a result of Tropical Storm Hanna; and

WHEREAS, said declaration of a local emergency identified the need to terminate the local emergency once emergency actions had been completed and were no longer necessary for the health and safety of the city and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, all emergency actions have been completed and the declaration of local emergency is no longer necessary for the health and safety of the city and its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Newport News, Virginia, that all necessary emergency actions necessitated by Tropical Storm Hanna having been taken, the health and safety of the city and its citizens have been preserved, and therefore it hereby terminates, effective September 7, 2008, the declaration of a local emergency made on September 5, 2008.
