

**RESOLUTION NO. 11709-08**

A SPECIAL RESOLUTION CANCELING THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING OF NOVEMBER 12, 2008, AND RESCHEDULING SAME FOR NOVEMBER 6, 2008.

WHEREAS, Sec. 4.06 of the Newport News City Charter provides that the City Council is to provide for the time and place of regular meetings which shall not be less frequently than once per month; and

WHEREAS, Sec. 2-21 of the City Code establishes the time and place of regular council meetings, but provides that changes to the schedule may be made by the council pursuant to special resolutions of council; and

WHEREAS, the regular council meeting which would have occurred on Veteran's Day, November 11, 2008, was moved to November 12, 2008, by operation of Section 2-21 of the City Code, which provides that in cases where a regular meeting falls on a legal holiday, the meeting shall be held on the next succeeding day which is not a legal holiday; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to cancel its regular meeting of November 12, 2008, and reschedule same for November 6, 2008, at 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Newport News, Virginia, that it desires to, and hereby does, cancel its regular meeting of November 12, 2008, and reschedule same for November 6, 2008.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall immediately cause a notice of this meeting cancellation and rescheduling action to be published in a newspaper generally circulated in Newport News in order to inform the public of the Council's action.
