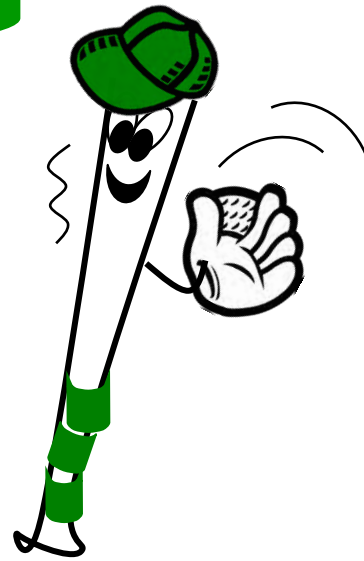

Whether you are new to our facility or have been here many, many times, we want all of our guests to have the best possible experience each time they visit the Stoney Run Athletic Complex!



Each year, we try to make improvements to the complex and, for 2012, we are pleased to announce the following facility enhancements:

- Infield irrigation has been installed on every field to keep fields watered throughout play as needed.
- 10lb. bagged ice is now available for purchase on-site.
- We have added four, 20' x 20' shade tents at various locations around the complex.
- During warm weather, we will now have misting fans out to help our patrons stay cool.
- Polar Blast Icees are now for sale in refillable cups that change color once turning cold!
- We now sell lip balm and sunscreen in the concession stand.

In case you didn't already know . . .

- Stoney Run Park and the Stoney Run Athletic Complex are owned by the City of Newport News and operated by the **Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism**. Any reference to "we" in this package refers to the City of Newport News and the Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism.
- The Front Gate on Warwick Blvd generally opens no earlier than 7am or 1 hour prior to the scheduled start time of the activity.
- Complex gates (including field access) open 1 hour prior to first games of that day.
- All field maintenance is performed solely by (City) Stoney Run Staff. Dressing or re-dragging of fields prior to the start of each game is mandated by the tournament director. If the tournament director has contracted field maintenance services, teams must allow staff time to work on fields. Times will be coordinated with the tournament director.
- The Concession Stand is open during most operational hours and accepts Cash, MasterCard, Visa and American Express.
- We do not charge gate fees to patrons or teams. These charges are subject to admissions taxes being paid by anyone that charges them (even the City). We hope that by keeping our rental fees and concession prices reasonable along with providing many other quality services, you will want to come back to Stoney Run again and again.
- Teams are welcome to bring a 10 x 10 pop up tent for shade. Please note that placement may be determined by facility staff in order to maintain safe traffic flow and views of fields. It can get windy so please be safe and monitor tents closely and/or take them down if it gets too breezy.
- We strive to provide a clean and safe athletic venue for all of our visitors. We provide on-site custodial staff to empty trash and recycling receptacles throughout each event. We believe it is important for patrons visiting in the morning to have the same safe and clean environment as patrons visiting in the afternoon or evening. To help ensure this happens, we appreciate all of our guests using the provided receptacles and "getting the trash in the cans."

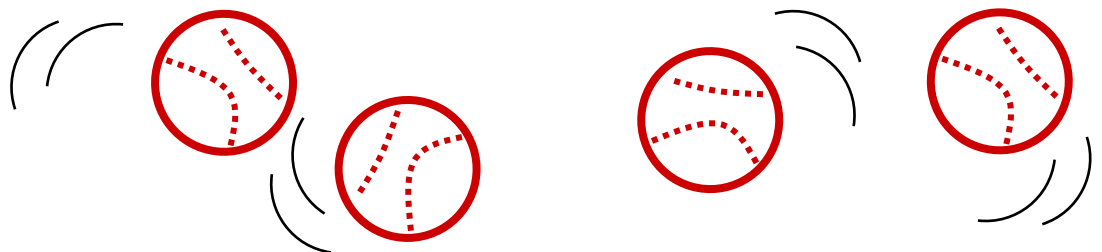


- **We follow the national standard for storm delays for outdoor activities which is "Hear it clear it, see it flee it."** If thunder is heard or lightning is seen, a mandatory game delay of 30 minutes will be enforced and all facility patrons (players, guests coaches and officials) must leave the complex and batting cages and seek shelter. Announcements will be made and the hotline (757-886-7868) will be updated as needed with delay information.
- Our two batting cages, located past Field #3, are available on a first-come, first-served basis during regular daylight operational hours. Please be courteous to other teams by limiting your usage and sharing when others are waiting. We do not have pitching machines but cages are equipped with L-screens.
- Please make sure you secure and lock all of your personal belongings in your vehicle before leaving the parking areas and entering the complex.
- We do not maintain a lost and found when the facility has been rented by an outside group but do return found items to the tournament director. Please check with your tournament director for lost or misplaced items.
- Fields that are not rented are not available for practice/warm-up.
- Only 2 teams are allowed on each field at one time. Fields in use are not available for warm-up, including the area behind portable fencing during games.
- We have a playground located between Fields #3 and #4. Please keep an eye out for foul balls!
- We really care about safety and how things look. We want you to enjoy the atmosphere. We take pride in our fields, our landscaping and our facility as a whole. Our trees, mulched areas and bushes are not part of the playground. Please do not climb trees, pull off limbs/leaves or walk on the bushes. Please do not throw balls against dugouts, fences or the concession stand.



The following activities are not permitted inside the green complex gates, but are allowed in the general parking lot areas:

- We recommend you leave your pets safely at home. If they are traveling with you, they must be kept in the parking areas and not within the complex gates, and they must be on a leash at all times.
- **Skateboards, scooters, bicycles and skates are not permitted within the complex and we don't recommend** children ride them in the parking or spectator entrance areas where there are so many people and vehicles coming and going. If you choose to bring these types of toys, they must be used on paved or sidewalk areas only in the parking areas (no riding on benches, curbs, landscape areas, etc.) and may not be used around any entrance gate thereby interfering with patrons entering or exiting the facility.
- Outside food that has not been purchased from the Stoney Run Athletic Complex is not permitted within the gates. Although we do not allow guests to bring their own food inside the green gates of the complex, you are welcome to eat at your car as long as you clean up. Additionally, teams are permitted to bring their own fresh fruit into the complex if they desire to do so and are permitted one team cooler with drinks for the players only. Remember, we have 10lb. bags of ice for sale so you can fill your cooler with ice when you get here!
- Smoking is not permitted in the complex, entrance areas, or around the batting cages. It is permitted in the parking areas but please make sure all cigarette butts are disposed of properly and not thrown on the ground or in the bushes. We have provided smoking urns around the parking area.





Did you know . . .

- Stoney Run was built on the site of an old landfill. This re-purposed park is still in the early stages and we will be adding additional multi-purpose fields, a community center (opening in the fall of 2012!), trails, a birdwatching observation tower and many other outdoor activities in the years to come. In 2005, this facility was honored with an Environmental Stewardship award and we strive to operate in a manner deserving of this award. We have recycle bins throughout the complex and offer refillable souvenir cups as a cost-efficient alternative to the disposable paper cups. **We were also chosen to be the site of "Extreme Stream Make-over" in 2011. Three Rain gardens were installed** on the property that are sustained by rain water run-off. Two are located on either side of the drive up to the traffic circle and one is outside the fence behind field #4.
- The Backstop Grill, located conveniently in the center of the complex, offers daily favorites such as hot dogs, hamburgers, barbeque, nachos and the ever-popular soft pretzels. We also serve seasonal items like ice cream, soups, and our new Polar Shock Icees! Our basic menu is on the last page of this welcome packet or you can go to www.nnparks.com and click Athletic Facilities (Stoney Run Athletic Complex). Specials and seasonal items may vary.
- In addition to weekend rentals, Parks, Recreation and Tourism hosts adult softball and kickball leagues on weekday evenings from April—October. For information on upcoming leagues, contact the Warwick Recreation Center at 757-591-4892. For information on renting fields by the hour for team practices or upcoming clinics, camps or classes in soccer, baseball, softball or field hockey, please call 757-886-7868.
- We are working very hard to maintain quality athletic fields and amenities at Stoney Run at reasonable prices. Please help us by working with us and being respectful of the grounds, equipment and landscaping.
- **Alcoholic beverages are never permitted anywhere at Stoney Run Park including the roadways, parking areas, open spaces or athletic complex.**

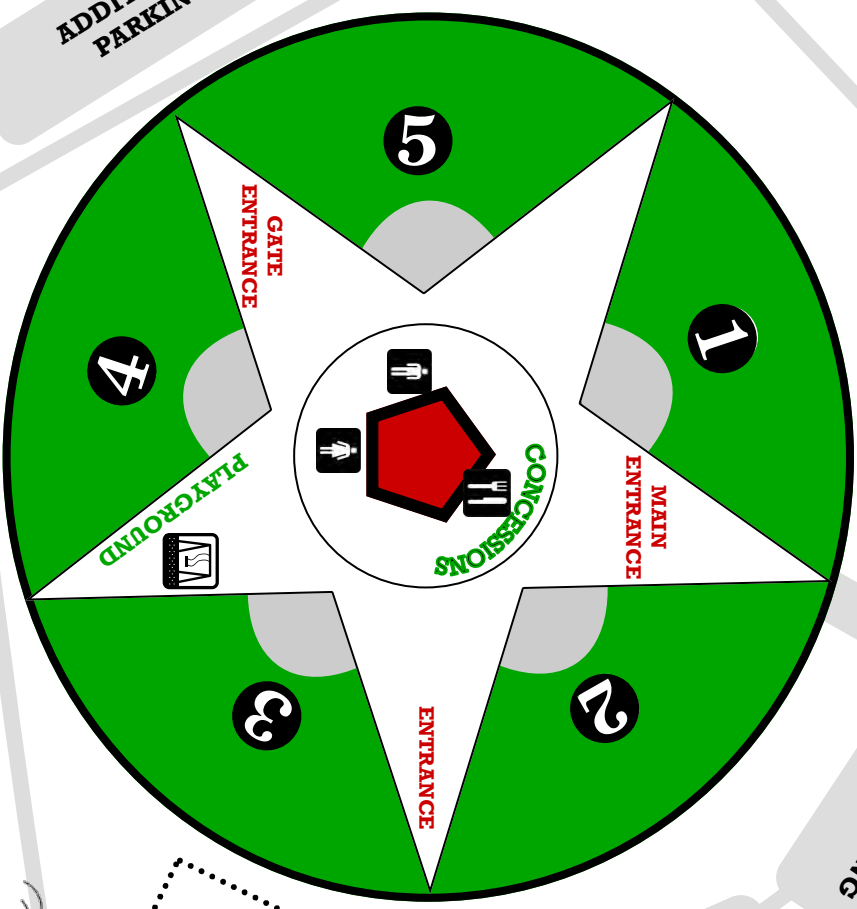

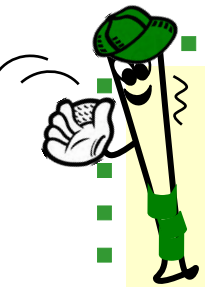
