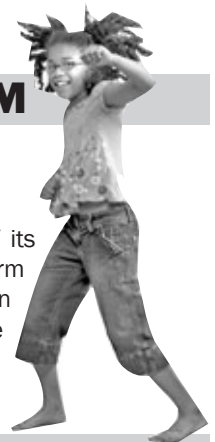
YOUTH PATROL DRILL TEAM
