loose-leaf collection, a new report will be distributed.

Since the City would like the CAC's input into the bulk waste call-in system, a renewed focus was placed on this issue. The CAC decided that they would review the bulk waste call-in system packets mailed to them last fall and arrive at the February meeting prepared to thoroughly discuss the issue. At such time, the City would like their concerns, comments, and suggestions regarding such a proposed change. The CAC also decided that unless otherwise requested by the City, the subcommittees would review/discuss one topic at a time vs. several subcommittee topics at once. This would allow all CAC members to gain a full understanding of each topic.
