Place the following in your recycling cart:

- Glass: bottles and jars
- Metal: food and beverage cans, aluminum cans, pie pans and foil
- Plastic: bottles and containers with a neck and #1 or #2 on the bottom
- Paper: envelopes, mail, brown paper bags, newspapers and inserts, phone books, magazines
- Cardboard / Paperboard: cereal boxes, tissue boxes, corrugated cardboard that are broken down and flattened to fit inside the cart, allowing for the lid to close completely

NOTICE: From time to time, items may be discontinued or added to the program.

Please rinse containers. We cannot accept poison containers, empty paint cans, styrofoam, #5 plastics, plastic grocery or newspaper bags. **Recyclables placed outside of cart will not be collected.**

If you are a homeowner and you do not currently have a recycling container, please call 269-2700 to determine if you are eligible for one. If you are eligible, a container will be delivered to you.

Is your current recycling container too small? Call 269-2700 to get a larger container if you are a blue cart recycler, or an additional bin if you are a bin recycler.
