SCOPE OF WORK: Includes realignment of an intersection, closure of an existing median opening, creation of turn lanes and conversion of a span wire traffic signal to a mast arm traffic signal, as detailed on the plans and specifications. **This project is a City Administered, VDOT project with Federal and State funding sources. All State and Federal rules apply. The contractor is responsible for satisfying all documentation and form submissions of the State and Federal requirements including but not limited to material certifications, material sampling and test results, weigh sheets and delivery tickets, etc..., as per the latest edition of the VDOT Road and Bridge Specifications and Standards.**

This bid consists of plans, technical specifications as amended by Special Conditions and Instructions, and the Department of Engineering Standard Specifications that may be obtained at the Office of the Department of Engineering, City Hall Building, 8th floor, Newport News, Virginia 23607, telephone number (757) 926-8611 for a non-fundable fee of \$15.75 each including tax per copy.
