SCOPE OF WORK: Includes the development of working drawings, fabrication and installation of a variety of sign types to include district gateway signage, major intersection signage, and circulatory directional signage to provide for a structured system of wayfinding signage in the primary route corridors surrounding Oyster Point (Phase I implementation of the Citywide Wayfinding Sign Program) be completed within 180 calendar days from the Notice-to- Proceed date. This project is a City Administered, VDOT project with Federal and State funding sources. All State and Federal rules apply. *The Virginia Department of Transportation, Hampton Roads District Office of Civil Rights, has established a goal of 0% DBE participation for this project.

This bid consists of plans, technical specifications as amended by Special Conditions and Instructions, and the Department of Engineering Standard Specifications that may be obtained at the Office of the Department of Engineering, City Hall Building, 8th floor, Newport News, Virginia 23607, telephone number (757) 926-8611 for a non-fundable fee of \$15.75 each including tax per copy.
