All contractors shall be made aware that portion of this project is funded from the Virginia Clean Water Revolving Loan Fund (VCWRLF).

SCOPE OF WORK: The project includes the furnishing of all equipment, labor, materials and supervision necessary for the Pump Station No. 44 Renovation, including but not limited to mobilization, demobilization, demolition and reconstruction of the control building, demolition and replacement of select equipment; rehabilitation of a the wet well; the furnishing of all equipment, generator and appurtenances, electrical and controls, and HVAC equipment; all site work; and all incidental work thereto as detailed in the Contract Documents. The Contractor will be responsible for furnishing equipment, labor and materials for flow bypassing, traffic control and site restoration.

This bid consist of plans, technical specifications as amended by Special Conditions and Instructions, and the Department of Engineering Standard Specifications that may be obtained at the Office of the Department of Engineering, City Hall Building, 8th floor, Newport News, Virginia 23607, telephone number (757) 926-8611 for a non-fundable fee of \$15.75 each including tax per copy. If the bidder does not have a current set, they shall be purchased prior to submitting a bid and shall be maintained on the job site at all times until the completion of the project.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to award a contract in whole or in part, and to waive any informality in the procurement process. Bidders making errors may request withdrawal of their bids by giving written notice, including original work papers, within two business days after the bid opening.
