

PPEA Public Notice

The City of Newport News Purchasing Department has received and accepted for public notice and conceptual phase consideration an unsolicited proposal under the Public-Private Education Facilities and Infrastructure Act of 2002, Virginia Code §56-575.1 through §56-575.18 (PPEA), for “Improved Customer Service and Operational Cost Reduction for the Newport News Department of Human Services”. In accordance with the PPEA published procedures, the City of Newport News Purchasing Department:

- Has received an unsolicited proposal under the PPEA
- Intends to evaluate the proposal
- May negotiate an interim or comprehensive agreement with the proposer based on the proposal; and
- Will accept for simultaneous consideration any competing proposals that comply with the Model Guidelines for the City of Newport News adopted by the Responsible Public Entity (RPE), which are located at <http://www.nngov.com/city-council/city-council-actions/2010-legislation/may-11-2010/R11997-10.pdf>, and the PPEA.

Copies of the unsolicited proposals submitted as a result of this public notice shall be available upon request, subject to the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), Code of Virginia Code, Newport News City Code, and the PPEA. Additionally, this notice, the PPEA Model Guidelines, and the unsolicited proposal will be posted on the City of Newport News website at www.nngov.com/purchasing, and the Commonwealth of Virginia’s website at www.eva.virginia.gov.

The City of Newport News Purchasing Department will accept for simultaneous consideration any competing proposals that comply with the provisions of the PPEA. Proposals shall be accepted until close of business day, eastern daylight savings time, on Thursday, March 24, 2011 at close of business day. No additional proposals that are prepared in response to this PPEA public notice shall be accepted after this date and time. Any vendor submitting a competing proposal shall provide the City of Newport News Purchasing Department one original of its proposal and 10 copies.
