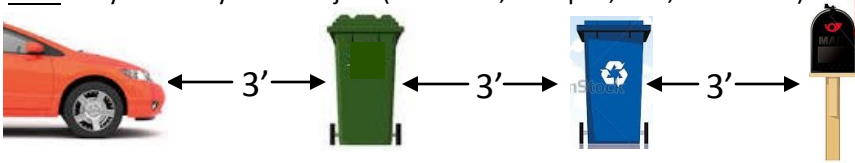


Recycling *RULES!*



Place recycling cart at the curb by 7 a.m. on your collection day at least 3 feet away from any other object (trash cart, bulk pile, cars, mailboxes).



Unbagged recyclables are preferred for easier sorting—watch the video on nnva.gov/recycle!

*No Yard Waste (please compost at home or take to the Recovery Operations Center—see bottom)



*No Clothing or Shoes (please take to the thrift store for reuse or recycling)

Main Street Library (110 Main St) * Briarfield Fire Station (5844 Marshall Ave)
Hiddenwood Fire Station (12455 Warwick Blvd) * Oyster Point Fire Station
(685 Oyster Point Rd) * NN Park Fire Station (13561 Jefferson Ave) *
Recovery Operations Center (550 Atkinson Way—open 8-4, Mon-Sat only)

Recyclables accepted curbside...

Plastic Jars, Jugs, Bottles & Tubs

— Emptied and Rinsed!



Drink bottles and jugs; shampoo, soap and detergent bottles and jugs; yogurt & dairy tubs; condiment jars; **leave the caps/lids on loosely.**

NOT ACCEPTED: Styrofoam, clothes hangers, plastic poison or automotive fluid containers, disposable tableware (plates, knives, forks, spoons).



NEW!!

Cartons — Emptied, Rinsed and tightly capped (not flattened)!

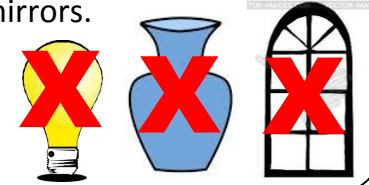
TYPES: milk, juice, broth, soup, wine, etc.



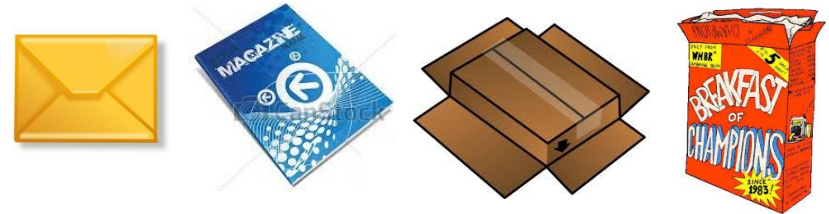
Glass Bottles and Jars— Emptied and Rinsed!



NOT ACCEPTED: Ceramic dishes/ovenware, vases, light bulbs, windows/mirrors.



Cardboard (flattened) and Paper



NOT ACCEPTED: Plastic coated paper, greasy paper, food contaminated paper, napkins/tissues.



Metal Cans and Pans— Emptied and Rinsed!



NOT ACCEPTED: Paint cans, scrap metal.
